5,500 CFL's Installed!



On September 11th, 2007, over 500 UNC-A freshmen students replaced 5,500 incandescent light bulbs with the more energy efficient CFL's at the Asheville Housing Authority's low-income rental developments. This project will offset over 1,600 tons of carbon dioxide!





2007 Projects:

During the week of July 9th, the first 350 CFL's were installed in the Asheville Housing Authority's Livingston apartments for a total offset of 102 tons.

According to the EPA, if every household in the U.S. replaced one light bulb with an compact fluorescent light bulb (CFL), it would prevent enough pollution to equal removing one million cars from the road.
